Rebel wrestling was in Lewistown this past weekend for a girls-only tournament. Our senior placed first, and our junior placed fifth. The Broadus tournament was canceled, so no boys competed.

For the basketball teams, the JV girls played Shepherd in Custer on Tuesday, and they won 41-35. On Thursday, the varsity played in Forsyth where the boys won 45-39 and the girls lost 40-43. In Broadview on Friday, the JV girls won 34-23, the JV boys lost 23-24, the varsity girls won 40-32, and the varsity boys won 52-40. The final game for the weekend was in Custer against Northern Cheyenne; the boys won 68-42, and the girls won 62-9. The varsity boys remain undefeated while the varsity girls are 8-3.

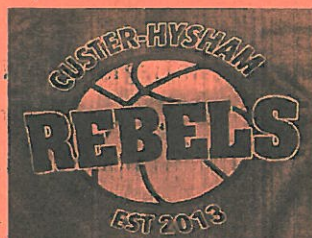
# Driver Education
