1. Attends school regularly and is seldom tardy – no more than 4 unexcused absences and/or tardies per quarter (a student can have four absences AND four tardies and earn an “S”).
2. Respects school property and observes classroom rules consistently.
3. Works diligently and uses time effectively – turns assignments in on time.
4. Displays courtesy and respect – complies with guidelines of the school handbook.
