

## PENALTIES

### CA ED. CODE 48293

The SARB may present an attendance contract and may recommend a change in school placement. Failure to comply with the contract can result in a citation to appear in court.

#### 1st Conviction:

Fine is up to \$100, plus possible penalties.

#### 2nd Conviction:

Fine is up to \$250, plus possible penalties.

#### Third or Subsequent Conviction:

Fine is up to \$500, plus possible penalties.

**Parents are responsible for a child's attendance from the age of 6 until the age of 18.**

Ed. Code 48200

Failure to enroll your student in an approved educational program could result in a \$2,500 fine + 1 year county jail + probation up to 5 years.  
P.C. 272(a)(1), (a)(i).

La multa puede ser de hasta \$500, más posibles sanciones.

Al no inscribir a su estudiante en un programa educativo aprobado podría resultar en una multa de \$2,500 + 1 año de cárcel del condado + libertad condicional de hasta 5 años.

Recibira la 2ª Carta de absentismo escolar. A la 2ª Carta de absentismo escolar se reunirá con el administrador o el Equipo de Revisión de Asistencia estudiantil.

**Novena (9) Ausencia Injustificada:**  
Clasificada como Absentismo Escolar Habitual. Recibirá la 3ª Carta de Absentismo Escolar y puede ser remitida a la Junta de Revisión de Asistencia Escolar.

**Nota:** Más de diez (10) ausencias injustificadas se consideran excesivas.

## EXCUSED ABSENCE

- PERSONAL ILLNESS, INCLUDING MENTAL AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH.
- QUARANTINE AS DIRECTED.
- PERSONAL MEDICAL (DENTAL, OPTOMETRIC, OR CHIROPRACTIC APPOINTMENTS). MEDICAL NOTE RECOMMENDED.
- FUNERAL SERVICES FOR IMMEDIATE FAMILY (LIMITED TO ONE DAY INTO THE STATE, OR THREE DAYS OUT OF STATE).
- STUDENT SERVING JURY DUTY.
- PERSONAL COURT APPEARANCE (REQUIRES VERIFICATION).
- SPENDING TIME WITH A MEMBER OF IMMEDIATE FAMILY WHO IS AN ACTIVE-DUTY MEMBER OF THE MILITARY SERVICE.
- OBSERVANCE OF A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY OR CEREMONY OR EVENT.
- COLLEGE VISIT (REQUIRES VERIFICATION).
- OTHER REASONS ARE WITHIN THE DISCRETION OF SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS AND BASED ON PUPIL'S CIRCUMSTANCES

## THE SARB PROCESS AS ESTABLISHED BY LAW

### **Third (3) - Unexcused Absence:**

Classified as a Truant.  
1st Truancy Letter sent home.

### **Sixth (6) - Unexcused Absence:**

Second truancy.  
2nd Truancy Letter & meeting  
with administrator or Student  
Attendance Review Team.

### **Ninth (9) - Unexcused Absence:**

Classified as a Habitual Truant.  
3rd Truancy Letter and may be  
referred to the School  
Attendance Review Board.

**Note:** More than ten (10)  
unexcused absences is  
considered to be excessive.

- PARENT'S ILLNESS OR MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS.
- MISSING THE BUS OR TRANSPORTATION PROBLEMS.
- ATTENDING SPORTING EVENTS OR CONCERTS.
- PARTICIPATING IN A STUDENT DEMONSTRATION OFF-CAMPUS.
- WAITING FOR SERVICE OR REPAIR PEOPLE TO ARRIVE.
- NON-SCHOOL RELATED TRAVELING SPORTS TEAM.
- DMV APPOINTMENT OR DRIVING CLASSES.
- STUDENT/PARENT OVERSLEEPING.
- FAMILY ERRANDS.

**All absences must be verified or  
the absence becomes an  
unexcused absence or truancy.**
