Immunization Requirement for Seniors

This is to inform you that your child will need to show proof of a meningococcal conjugate vaccination before entering twelfth grade. All twelfth graders will need to show proof of receiving two doses unless the first dose was given after 16 years of age. In this case, only one dose after age 16 is required. This vaccination will prevent your student from a severe form of bacterial meningitis as well as other illnesses caused by this bacterium. (Immunization record is attached for your convenience).

RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION FOR IMMUNIZATION – if you choose not to immunize your child based on religious reasons or **if you have an existing religious exemption on file for your child,** please note that there is a new rule in Illinois that requires a form to be completed and signed by you and your doctor.
