Happy December! We are nearing the end of the second quarter. We are continually learning new things every day. We are busy working on numbers and learning about our new Superkid, Doc.

Students have been writing words, talking about writing sentences with one uppercase letter, finger spaces between words, and using end punctuation.

Students are doing a great job recognizing upper- and lower-case letters of the alphabet, letter sounds, and numbers 0-20. We will continue working on these skills every day. We are also working on identifying beginning, middle, and end sounds in words.

ABC Letter Sounds & Names:

Keep practicing saying their letter names and sounds at home. I highly encourage students go through these cards nightly.

Sight Words:

I highly encourage students go through these cards' multiple times a week.

Academic Standards

Math:

1. Count to 100 by 1's, 2's, 5's, and 10's.
2. Can count forward beyond 20.
3. Can count backwards from 20 consecutively.
4. Can write & identify numbers 0-20 and make a model.
5. Students can add and subtract numbers to 5.
6. Students can compare three shapes and describe their similarities and differences using attributes and vocabulary.
7. Students can sort objects into groups.
8. Students can compare two whole numbers 0-100, using greater than, less than, and equal.

Reading:

1. Know letter names & sounds.
2. Fluently read all Quarter 1 & 2 sight words.
3. Students can write words using the correct letter to represent a sound.
4. Students can create a list of three or more words that rhyme with a given word.
5. Students can distinguish between spelled words by identifying the sounds of letters that differ.

Writing:

1. Write all letters of the alphabet.
2. Students can sort and create a rule for objects they are giving, and verbally explain their rule.
3. Student can create pieces of functional writing with help.

Science:

1. Dealing with weather.
 - * Weather Patterns, Weather Hazards, and Energy from the Sun.

Social Studies:

1. Geography
 - *Identify the globe and a map.
 - *Identify between land and water on a globe or map.
 - *Identify the United States of America and Idaho on a map.
