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Discussion: I am on the proposal, Scott and I sat down with Dr. Hattrick back in late October

Youth on - high school access. Youth programs are both willing to support this.

Not all of the material would be donated, we do have a lot of commitment and there is still a lot of fundraising that needs to happen. We haven't even spoken to some of the bigger businesses. On school property how would it be available to the community? At the school district's discretion, just like the gyms.

If it can be here, coaches have most of the control and athletic director.

Concern is the upkeep and moving forward with another building to maintain when we have a pool we can't keep running, the cost of electricity and an auditorium that is crumbling.

Location? South side of parking, there is a flat spot that doesn't get used. Concerns especially when we don't take care of well now, so I'm curious as to future cost.

The maintenance director might have a better idea of cost. I imagine the non profit that is gifting it has a vested interest and will continue to invest in it.

We're comparing a new building with buildings that have been here for years. I don't think he's come here to get the okay today, but to get the questions answered

**Dr. Hattrick:** We would want to know what questions the committee was working on or what is the specific ask?

**Discussion:** As a district are we wanting to move forward on some level, so that's up to whoever makes a motion. What are we okaying here? You can amend the motion. I don't know what to ask for? Attorney cost \$410 an hour.

There is a building down at track that was done not that long ago, so you could look that up

The list of questions came from dr. Hattrick and yourself and we answered most of them. Some will be answered as the permitting goes and that the non profit will pay for without getting legal advice. I think that's where we would start with those and getting legal advice there. This is money well spent to promote this project.

Just worried about the optics of spending funds when our other buildings are crumbling around us. Just giving a blank check is an issue.
