DIRECTIONS & RUBRIC

- You will be making a book trailer for one of your summer reading books.
- Time permitting, you will present these to the class.
- Each slide / frame must have an image, otherwise it will not be counted.

WHAT GOES ON EACH SLIDE / FRAME

- SLIDE 1: INTRO Include the title and author of the text and the picture should be of an image that summarizes the novel. DO NOT just use the cover of the novel. ___/10
- SLIDE 2: SETTING Describe the setting in two sentences and include a picture that encapsulates what the setting of the novel looks like. ___/10
- SLIDES 3-5: CHARACTER Pick three characters and create a slide for each character. Describe the main character and two minor characters in two sentences EACH and include a picture of what you think the characters would look like.

- SLIDE 6: EXPOSITION Summarize the exposition of the story in two sentences and include an image that summarizes that part of the novel. ___/10
- SLIDE 7: RISING ACTION Summarize the rising action of the story in two sentences and include an image that summarizes that part of the novel. ___/10
- SLIDE 8: CONFLICT Summarize the confllict of the story in two sentences and include an image that summarizes that part of the novel. ___/10
- SLIDE 9: FALLING ACTION Summarize the falling action of the story in two sentences and include an image that summarizes that part of the novel. ___/10
- SLIDE 10: RESOLUTION Summarize the resolution of the story in two sentences and include an image that summarizes that part of the novel. ____/10
- SLIDE II: THEMES Summarize the theme of the novel and explain why it is the theme in two sentences. Include an image that summarizes the theme. ___/10
- Include intro and exit music on the first and last slides of the book trailer.
