The fifth member of the board whom will be representing Round Rock community hasn't been elected. A special election will be conducted to fill the position.

In 2022, the Navajo Nation Council approved the Plan-6 School Board Re-Appportionment which allowed one school board to govern more than one school. LCS operated under one governing board with five other schools for two school years, 2023-2024.

In 2024, the Navajo Nation Council approved the 2024 School Board Reapportionment Plan which allowed each school to return to having its own governing board members.

The new members will be participating in the school's annual corporate meeting later this month and will be conducting their first board meeting in February.
