Lineup and Parade Procedures:

Walkers and Floats:

The parade lineup will begin no later than 5:30P.M.! The parade will start no later than 7:00P.M.! Plan accordingly!

The parade route is as follows:

- NEW ROUTE: Begin/Line up at 4th St. / Court St. (next to courthouse), Turn left on 4th St., Turn right on Washington, Turn left on East Main, Turn right on Northington, Turn slight right on Doster Rd, End at Stanley Stadium (South parking lot)
- Follow officer instructions on where to park floats and parade vehicles. Plan to breakdown and disperse quickly! We are under strict instructions not to loiter at the stadium after the parade has finished!

Behavior Regulations:

1. Maintain school appropriate behavior!

- 2. NO DJ'S; themed music is permitted
- 3. No throwing water balloons or spraying crowd with water, etc.
- 4. Throw/handout candy to crowd by aiming towards the ground; DO NOT throw candy/beads/ etc. at the crowd.
- 5. Floats should be safely built, with nothing hanging out into the crowd's space.

6. Float/flatbed entries will be required to provide two adult walkers on each side of the float/flatbed to ensure that no one darts into parade traffic.

7. Proceed at a reasonable and safe speed.

8. Please allow a reasonable space between groups, but no large gaps.

9. ONLY PHS students and Autauga County ABOE employees are allowed to ride student floats!

10. ALL student floats MUST have an ACBOE employee present at all times, including the name and signature of that employee in the above application.

11. Driver of any entry must be an adult with a valid driver's license and must comply with all state laws. 12. All entries must have a DRIVER AND PASSENGER (a spotter of legal driving age) to help ensure safety.

13. Maximum float/flatbed dimensions: height of 13 feet, 6 inches; width of 8 feet, 6 inches; total entry length of 57 feet. IF ENTRIES ARE LARGER THAN 57 FEET LONG, 8 AND A HALF FEET WIDE, AND/OR 13 AND A HALF FEET IN HEIGHT, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE PARADE.
