

Call Out for January 14, 2022

This is Richard Dennis, Superintendent of Elmore County Public Schools.

The COVID spike is continuing upward this week with 406 students and 96 employees reporting testing positive. This spike is expected to continue for a couple of more weeks which may impact more schools. Holtville High, Stanhope Elmore High, and Elmore County High Schools observed an e-day today due to the number of faculty and staff absences. Monday is MLK Holiday and at that time we will evaluate each school's status and determine if there is a need to shift to a virtual platform. If so, notification to parents and students will be made on Monday. Also, please be aware that bus routes in some areas will be delayed due to a shortage of drivers and substitute drivers. This situation may continue for the duration of the COVID spike.
