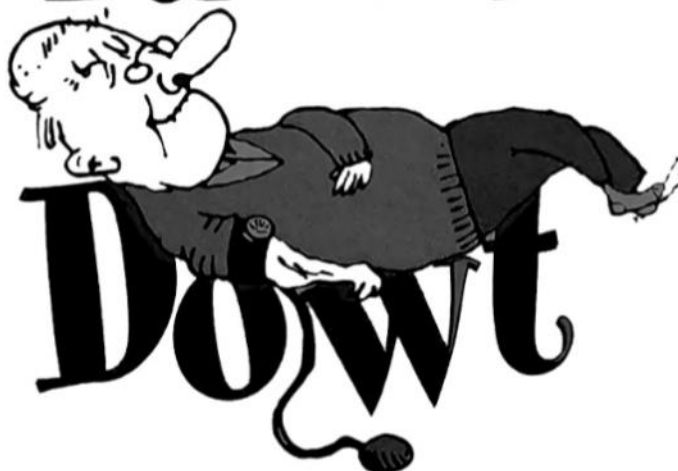

School Notes - Winter Weather Information:

When it comes to the cancellation of school, we will attempt to make that decision as early as possible for everyone’s safety and convenience. In making that decision, we will always err on the side of safety for our families. Since the weather can vary greatly across the Saxony attendance area, if we have school but you feel it is unsafe for your student to come to school because of weather related road conditions, please keep them at home. Just call the office to let us know and the absence will not be counted against your student. The safety of all of our students and families is a top priority for Saxony. If we cancel school, it will be announced through the various media outlets in our area. We encourage you to sign up for notifications from KFVS12 or the Southeast Missourian. We will send information through PlusPortals and via our **Saxony Lutheran App** as well. **If you have not done so, please download our app to receive the most up-to-date information as quickly as possible.** Weather conditions could also be such that we would have a delayed start or early dismissal. If we have a delayed start, it will be a two hour delay and school will begin at 9:50 a.m. with homeroom. With an early dismissal, we will make every effort to make that decision in a timely manner that allows for the safe transportation home for everyone.

Happy Winter, Crusaders!

Please pay close attention to deadlines listed below! Last month, the Sophomores who are Perry County residents visited the Perryville Area Career & Technology Center (PACTC). All students were given an application and course descriptions for the programs offered. If your student plans to apply for a class at the CTC for next year, they will need to turn in their application and faculty recommendation letter to me by Wednesday, February 7th. I will then gather the information needed and submit it to Mrs. Steif, the School Counselor at the PACTC, before their March 1st due date. Decisions about program admissions are finalized in May. On the morning of February 6th, our Cape Girardeau (Scott & Bollinger) County will be transported by bus to visit the Cape Girardeau Career & Technology Center. More details and a permission slip will be sent via email later this week. Students will be given applications and course descriptions. Any student wishing to apply for a program will need to return their application to me by Wednesday, February 14th.

Saxony Juniors from Perry County will also have an opportunity to apply for a special program that is new for the 2024-2025 school year. Representatives from the CEO Entrepreneurship Program will be visiting with Saxony Juniors from Perry County on Monday, February 5th, at 9:00 am. The CEO program will be overseen by the Perryville Area Career & Technology Center in conjunction with Midland Institute for Entrepreneurship and the Perry County Community Foundation of the Ozarks. Students will be able to apply for an internship-like program that would allow them to attend “class” on-site at a local business every day in the afternoons, like our CTC students do now. More detailed information will be forthcoming for those students eligible to apply. March 12th is the in-school ACT for all Juniors and for additional students who also signed up. Please be sure to get a good night’s sleep, eat a nutritious breakfast with some protein and carbs, and bring your #2 pencils and an approved calculator. I register the students for the test and students will be instructed about how to set up their MyACT accounts, if they do not have one already. More detailed information will be in an email in the near future. And finally, for Seniors planning to attend college next year, the FAFSA application is open! Please complete this as soon as possible; applications will be accepted until April 1st for the 2024-25 academic year.

Student Expectations for Crusader E-Learning Days

1. The expectations of Crusader E-Learning Days is that it will be valuable and move the class forward by one day, just as if we were in school! It is an expectation of all students to join each class via Teams. Each class period will last 30 minutes, and attendance will be taken.

2. The school day will last from 9:00 a.m. – 11:45 a.m. with a BLUE DAY schedule and a GOLD DAY Schedule as follows. Communication via email will give the students direction if the Crusader E-Learning Days will be a BLUE or GOLD DAY.

BLUE DAY

1st period = 9:00 – 9:30

2nd period = 9:45 – 10:15

3rd period = 10:30 – 11:00

4th period = 11:15 – 11:45

GOLD DAY

5th period = 9:00 – 9:30

6th period = 9:45 – 10:15

7th period = 10:30 – 11:00

Chapel/Small Group = 11:15 – 11:45

3. Teachers will be engaged with the students during these set times for Crusader E-Learning Days. Class instruction, activities, discussion, and/or assignments will be communicated on Teams during your scheduled class time. Teachers will inform and guide the students on how their class period will function as we work together to create a great learning environment and conduct class in a creative way.

4. As a student, you are expected to join via Teams for each class period and complete all course activities and assignments as instructed by your teacher. All completed assignments need to be submitted by the deadline assigned.

- Teams Etiquette
 - Join and be ready for class at the scheduled time.
 - Be dressed appropriately.
 - Find a good working space where you can sit and be ready for class.
 - Make sure your face is visible during the class, so your teacher knows that you are actively participating.

5. Academic honesty is one of the most important characteristics of a good school, and we expect all students to maintain high standards in all academic settings, including E-Learning. All work completed must be your own. You are not to copy, borrow, share work, or collaborate with other students unless the teacher has instructed you to do so. You may not use the internet, or any other sources (including people) not specifically approved by the teacher to complete your assignments. If you are unsure about what academic honesty means for an assignment, check with the teacher.

6. Students, you can contact your teachers via email anytime! To find a teacher's email, log into your email account and search the app "People" OR start a new email message, and click in the "TO" textbox, type the last name of your teacher, and select the correct name in the drop down. Make sure to send proper and respectful emails to contact your teacher. Expect responses from your teachers during normal school hours.

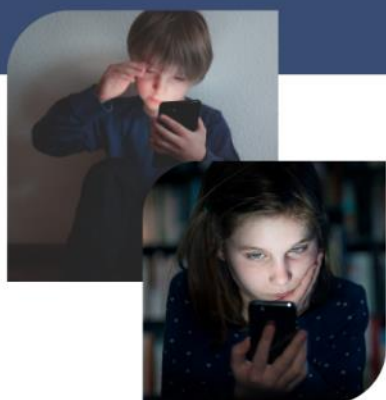
