Dress Down Day Guidelines for Middle School:

- 1. It is a dress down day with **NO costumes**.
- 2. You can wear jeans or sweatpants.
- 3. NO leggings are permitted
- 4. No jeans with holes are permitted, there are no exceptions to this rule.

PUMPKIN TRASHKETBALL

- Class is split into 2 teams. You need to use masking tape to mark 3 different shooting lines.
 - 2 Points for closet line to the basket
 - o 5 points for middle line
 - o 10 points for furthest line
- You will ask each team a Halloween question. The team has 5 seconds to provide 2 answers.
- If they provide 2 answers correctly the child that answered the question can choose which shooting line they would like to try and shoot from.
- The team with the highest points at the end of the game WINS!

HALLOWEEN LIMBO

- Parent Volunteer will play music and hold the limbo stick to sturdy it.
- Each child will walk underneath the limbo pole and bend backward to not touch the pole. The child can not touch the ground or anything else.
- If you touch the pole or can't stay standing, you lose the round and need to sit down. The last child standing is the winner!

SPOOKY CHARADES

- Divide the class into 2 teams. Have each player on each team take turns pulling a Halloween themed card.
- The player that pulled the card will be the one that acts out for their team to guess.
- The player acting cannot speak, use sounds, or point at objects. It must be only acting out gestures for the team to guess!
- When the hour glass finishes the team is out of time!
- If the team guesses the card within the timeframe they will earn 5 points.
- At the end; the team with the most points will win!

PUMPKIN PONG

- Each team has 6 cups to try to get the ping pong balls into; cups are in a triangle shape.
- Teams take turns trying to get one ping pong ball into each cup.
- First team to get a ping pong ball into each cup, WINS!

Kindergarten through Fifth Grade

Girls:

- 1. Flynn and O'Hara Plaid Jumper skirt must touch the top of the knees.
- 2. Hunter green long sleeved polo with St. Anne logo on the front.
- 3. Khaki Skort Skorts must touch the top of the knees.
- 4. Navy Blue or Hunter Green tights or knee socks.
- 5. Sneakers may be worn, no glitter, light up, wheeled or adorned sneakers. NO boots, heels, clogs, Hey Dudes, Uggs, Crocs, open-toed or backless shoes.

Boys:

- 1. Khaki dress pants/chinos with brown or black belt; belts are optional for grades K-2. NO cargo pants or jeans.
- 2. Hunter green long sleeved polo with St. Anne School logo on the front.
- 3. Sneakers may be worn, no light up, Hey Dudes, Crocs, wheeled or adorned sneakers.

Winter Uniform Requirements (Nov.1-March 31)

Grades Six to Eight

Girls:

- 1. Flynn and O'Hara plaid kilt skirt must touch the top of the knees.
- 2. Hunter green long sleeved polo with St. Anne logo on the front.
- 3. NO SNEAKERS Students may have a navy blue, black or brown leather or leather like dress shoe. NO boots, heels, clogs, Hey Dudes, Uggs, Crocs, open-toed or backless shoes.
- 4. Navy blue or Hunter green tights or knee socks.
- 5. ½ zip hunter green pullover (optional) NO sweatshirts besides the green pullover.

Boys:


- 1. Hunter green long sleeved polo with St. Anne logo on the front.
- 2. Khaki dress pants/chinos with brown or black belt. NO cargo pants or jeans
- 3. NO SNEAKERS Black or Brown leather or leather like school shoes are required.
- 4. Tan, black, white or hunter green over the ankle socks.
- 5. ½ zip hunter green pullover (optional) NO sweatshirts besides the green pullover.

Gym Uniform for Grades Kindergarten to Eighth Grade

- 1. NO JEWELRY, except post earrings for girls.
- 2. Hunter green St. Anne sweatshirt and sweatpants. (winter schedule)
- 3. Spirit wear, CYO, and Marathon Day Shirts are allowed.
- 4. St. Anne mesh gym shorts and St. Anne T-shirt (summer schedule)
- 5. Sneakers- NO dark soles.
- 6. White, green, or black over the ankle socks.
