Dear Parent/Guardian:

Please remember that your 5th grader may be due for updated immunizations prior to entering 6th grade.

Required vaccines for 11-year-old / 6th graders are as follows:

<u>Tdap</u>- All students 11 years old who are entering the 6th grade and all students entering grades 7-11 if a Tdap was not provided on or after the 11th birthday.

Varicella-2 doses if the 1st dose was not administered by age 13

The following vaccines are recommended:

MCV (meningococcal) - All 11-12-year-old and unvaccinated adolescents. Meningococcal disease is serious and is the leading cause of bacterial meningitis in children 2-18 years of age.

<u>HPV-</u> Boys and girls between the ages of 9 and 26. Although most HPV infections cause no symptoms and are self-limited, persistent HPV infection can cause certain cancers in males and females. Approximately half of new HPV infections occur in persons aged 15-24 years.

Please consult your child's medical provider or the local Health Department for recommendations regarding proper immunization.
