COURSE OVERVIEW

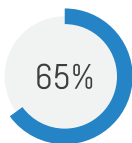

- 4 Follow all school rules and classroom procedures.

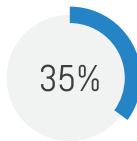
GRADING POLICY

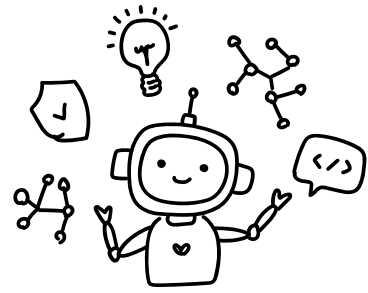
**if the absence is unexcused, students may receive a zero on missed assignments*
