8. Report of the Principal

Dr. Barbour reviewed the beginning of the school year, noting the changes implemented to respond to COVID impacts. She reviewed enrollment numbers, daily school operational procedures, and COVID safety procedures. She discussed the limitations on group gatherings, cleaning routines, and adjustments to a four lunch schedule for spacing. She additionally reviewed changes to contract tracing, to include close contacts within six feet of a positive report; parents have the option of returning the students to school with a mask for the ten day period, or quarantining for the ten day period. Mrs. Davis inquired about callouts and parent contact for procedures from community questions, and the system plan and publishing weekly reporting on the county website was reviewed. Dr. Barbour also discussed the addition of 13 new staff members, with three positions being added positions. She anticipates adding staff next year with added facility and growing student numbers.

Dr. Barbour discussed the release of End of Course data at the state and local level, and its disaggregate nature with not all students participating with varying levels of inperson learning last year. Additionally, she reviewed the implementation of MAP testing for fall, winter, and spring at the ninth and tenth grade levels as a growth measure versus an achievement measure, and its use at the high school level. She discussed that Houston County was part of a pilot consortium to use MAP data in the future for our system's evaluation measures instead of EOCs.

Dr. Barbour reviewed school level adjustments to dress code, including short length, hair color and nose rings.

• Facilities update

Dr. Barbour updated the School Council on the construction sites: the multipurpose building should be available the end of September, and the classroom addition is progressing ahead of schedule. Some supply receipts and weather have delayed some work on multipurpose, but the sites are ahead of schedule. Dr. Barbour complimented Parrish and their staff for their professionalism and regular communication with the school staff.
