First Reading: Open Budget Hearing
and Called Board Meeting- Summary
September 9, 2021

On Thursday, September 9, 2021 at 5:30 p.m. (est), the members of the Lanett City School Board, Pres. Gwen Harris-Brooks, Vice Pres. Tony Edmondson, David Gagnon, Gail Holley and Katie Walton, along with Superintendent Jennifer Boyd, Chief School Financial Officer Gwyn Barnes, Whittany Nolen, Principal Donna Bell and Suzanne Vaughn met at Lanett High School Media Center for the first reading of the 2021-2022 fiscal year budget and called board meeting. Due to Governor Ivy's State of Emergency Order , the meeting could not be held in the usual manner.

The meeting began at 5:30 p.m. (est). Followed by prayer. The meeting's agenda was approved and seconded.

New Business: The first reading and discussion of LCS budget for fiscal year 2021-2022. The board did not approve or vote on the budget at this meeting. A second reading is scheduled for the September regular board meeting on Monday, September 13, 2021. The 2021-2022 budget will be approved and voted on at that time.

Personnel: The Board approved, seconded and voted on the transfer of a Lanett City School employee from temporary, part-time to full-time.

The Board approved, seconded and voted on the transfer of a second Lanett City School employee from cafeteria manager to ISS/Alternative School instructional assistant, effective September 15, 2021.

The Board approved, seconded and voted to hire seven applicants for the 2021-2022 school year.

The meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
