

Covid Quarantine Guidelines WCSSD

Contact of a contact does not require any quarantine time or wearing of a mask.

EXPOSURE is defined as “within 6 feet of a positive case for a cumulative total of 15 minutes within a 24 hour period”.

Contact Exposure

- May stay at school and wear a mask x 10 days as long as they remain asymptomatic.
- May quarantine at home for 10 days from last date of exposure. *if becomes symptomatic please call you primary care doctor for guidance on testing.
- May do 5 days at home and if asymptomatic then return to school wearing mask for additional 5 days.
- If they test on day 5 or after and can provide a doctor’s office copy of the negative test results then they can return on day 6 with no mask.

Positive Person

- Quarantine at home for 5 days from symptom onset or positive test date.
- May return to school on day 6 if asymptomatic on day 5 for 24 hours and wear a mask thru day 10.
- As long as symptoms last positive person should not return to school unless the symptom is a lingering cough or loss of taste/smell.

In-home Positive

- Must quarantine for 5 days after last date of exposure to positive case.
- If asymptomatic then can return wearing a mask for 5 days.

In home testing is not acceptable as we cannot be provided an official copy of the testing results and as the test may/may not be performed correctly.
