## Forecasting 2021-2022

Forecasting for the 2021-2022 school year begins on Monday, April 12, 2021. Please take this process seriously as what you forecast for determines classes offered and what your schedule will look like next year. **IT IS NECESSARY FOR ALL STUDENTS TO FORECAST.** 

## How to forecast

- All students will receive a forecasting sheet for the grade they will be in next year. In the box at the top of the form will be the required courses students must take for that grade level. You do not need to select these. They have been pre-selected for you.
  - NEXT YEAR SENIORS: You will be able choose if you would like to take English IV or College English. You MUST take either English IV -OR- College English to graduate.
  - NEXT YEAR JUNIORS & SENIORS: If you have already passed 3 years of high school math you are not required to take a 4<sup>th</sup> year to graduate. If you would like to take Pre-Calculus or Statistics as a junior or senior please circle it as an elective choice.
  - ➤ **NEXT YEAR JUNIORS & SENIORS:** You must take a 3<sup>rd</sup> Science class in order to graduate. Please choose an additional Science class as an elective choice if you have not already taken 3 years of Science.
- On the back of the form are elective choices available for the grade level you will be in next year.
  Please circle the electives you would like to take next year. Your grade level determines the number of electives you can pick:
  - Future 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> graders please circle one (1) elective class and write "alternate" next to another class you would like to take if you cannot be placed in your first choice
  - Future Freshmen please circle two (2) elective classes and write "alternate" next to 3 other classes you would like to take if you cannot be placed in your first choices.
  - Future Sophomores please circle three (3) elective classes and write "alternate" next to 3 other classes you would like to take if you cannot be placed in your first choices.
  - Future Juniors: please circle <u>four (4) elective classes</u> and <u>write "alternate" next to 3</u> <u>other classes</u> you would like to take if you cannot be placed in your first choices.
  - Future Seniors: please circle <u>five (5) elective classes</u> and <u>write "alternate" next to 3</u> other classes you would like to take if you cannot be placed in your first choices.

All forecasting sheets must be returned to your advisor or Ms. Kallunki no later than **Friday**, **April 23 by 4:00.** If the counseling office does not receive a forecasting sheet for you then the counseling department will select your electives for you.
