<u>Team members</u>: Our Cardiac emergency response team (CERT) is made up of 13 faculty/staff members. All 13 members will respond to any cardiac emergency.

PLEASE NOTE: ANYONE IN THE BUILDING CAN INITIATE A CARDIAC EMERGENCY RESPONSE and start CPR

If you suspect a cardiac emergency, please notify the front office to initiate the Cardiac Emergency Response Team.

Signs/Symptoms of Cardiac Emergency

- The person is not moving, unresponsive, or appears to be unconscious.
- The person does not have a distinguishable pulse.
- The person is not breathing normally or not breathing at all.

Team Member Roles:

Front Office Staff:

The role of our front office staff:

- Receive emergency call
- Ask the name of the victim
- Ask the location of the emergency
- Ask if 911 has been notified yet
- Make an all-call announcement stating, "Cardiac Emergency Response Team to room (Location of emergency)"

Paul Parsley, Katrina Wright, Brad Sanders, Tim Knox, Richard Skipper, SRO Forrest Blackburn:

The role of our administration team/SRO (if the emergency is not located in your immediate office area)

- Initiate 911 call if not already done
- Hold bells to keep students in their current location and keep halls clear
- Direct/Assist EMS providers to location of emergency
- Obtain Synergy Demographic Profile to give to EMS
- Initiate/maintain contact with appropriate central office staff
- Contact family member
- Record the time of all events and phone calls
- Follow EMS to local hospital and stay with student until parents arrive
- Assisting with CPR if necessary

Jason Creek, Jason Sanders, and Jon Spears:

The above team members are responsible for:

- Obtaining the closest AED and all other supplies in AED cabinet and report to location of emergency
- Assisting with CPR if necessary
- Escorting students or bystanders away from the location of the emergency

Amanda Bernhardt, Deana Crosslin

It will be the responsibility of the above team members (whoever arrives first) to:

- Record events of the emergency response
- Note time of arrival (or obtain time from first person to respond)
- Document time EMS was notified and time EMS arrived
- Document time family was notified
- Document treatment given and response to treatment
- Work with EMS to give an accurate account of events
- Assist with CPR if necessary

All remaining CERT members are to report to location of emergency and assist as needed

ROLES OF EVERY MEMBER IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY:

- Arrive on scene as soon as possible
- Note the time of arrival
- Assure scene safety
- Begin CPR, following basic life support guidelines as taught in CPR certification class
- Work as a team to provide CPR/AED, swapping team members to prevent fatigue

Things to remember

REMAIN CALM: You are not an asset to the situation if you are unable to remain calm

CHECK SCENE: Make sure the scene is safe and you are not putting yourself in danger

GET THE AED: If you are passing an AED cabinet on the way to the scene, grab the AED and other supplies. Even if it is not your designated responsibility, do it. It is better to have more AEDs than none.

AED Locations

- 1. Outside the Library entrance by the main office
- 2. In the cafeteria, near the bathrooms attached to the concession stands
- 3. Near the exit to the shop classrooms
- 4. Across the hall from special services office

- 5. In the field house
- 6. Baseball Facility
- 7. Softball Facility
