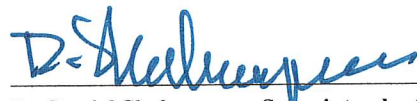
The next regularly scheduled Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, July 7, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., in the Board Room at Central Office.
