Extended Day Information

Extended Day services are provided **3:30 p.m. until 5:30 p.m.** on **Tuesdays and Wednesdays** based on data. In accepting the Extended Day Tutoring services, you are exercising your entitlement to improve your child's academic status. You understand that your child's selection to participate in Extended Day Tutoring is based on test data. You will receive a progress report on your child's progress in reading and math. ***Students will be dismissed from the Extended Day Program if he/she misses 2 or more days, receives excessive early dismissals, exhibits disruptive behavior, or for being consistently left past program hours.***

Extended Day Reminders

- Car riders and Walkers must **be picked up on time (both days) at 5:30.**
- **2 late pickups** will result in **dismissal** from the program.
- Walking students are asked to be accompanied by an adult at the stop sign to be released.
- Students are expected to attend both days.
- Students must be on their best behavior in order to participate/remain in the program.
- Extended day tutoring is held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 3:30- 5:30.
- The program will last 13 weeks.
- Students will receive Reading and Mathematics instruction as well as participate in Enrichment activities such as music, martial arts, dance, and theater.
- Students will receive monthly progress reports.
- Students may bring a snack.

Sleeping in Class

Many of our students are **sleeping** in class each day during instruction. This is causing them to miss a lot of learning. Please be sure your child is getting ample amount of rest to function in the classroom setting. **Thank you in advance for your complete cooperation.**

Tardies and Absences

Many of our students are missing quite a bit of school whether it is because of tardies, absences, or early dismissals. I am asking for parental support in this matter. Please have your children at school no earlier than 7:45AM. daily. We would love for them to join us for breakfast. Breakfast starts at 7:45AM and ends at 7:55AM. Learning begins at 8:00AM.
