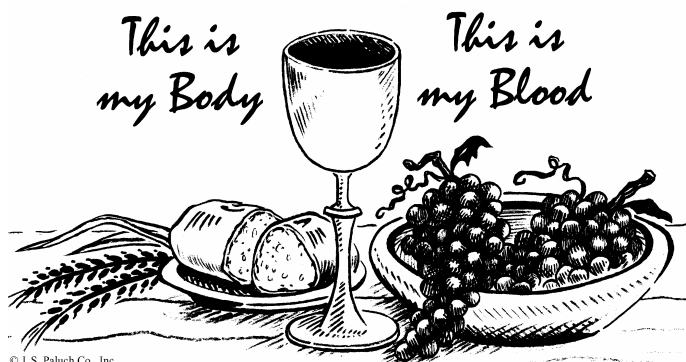

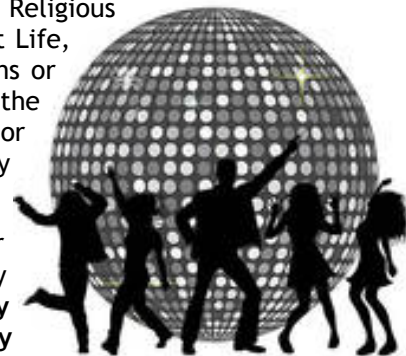

This is a major motion picture that treats a religious subject with great respect and understanding. 2012 TOGETHER IN MISSION

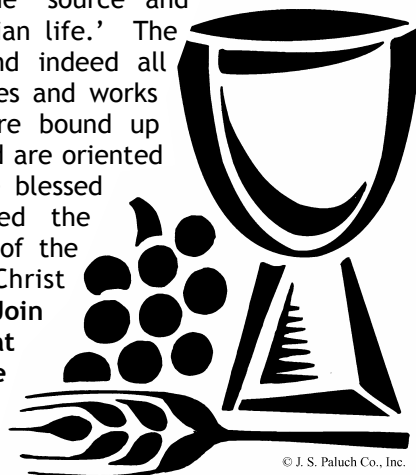

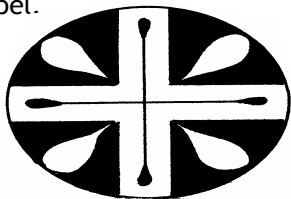
