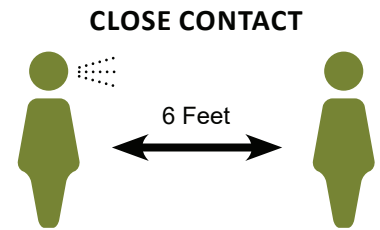


CLOSE CONTACT/ SYMPTOMATIC GUIDELINES

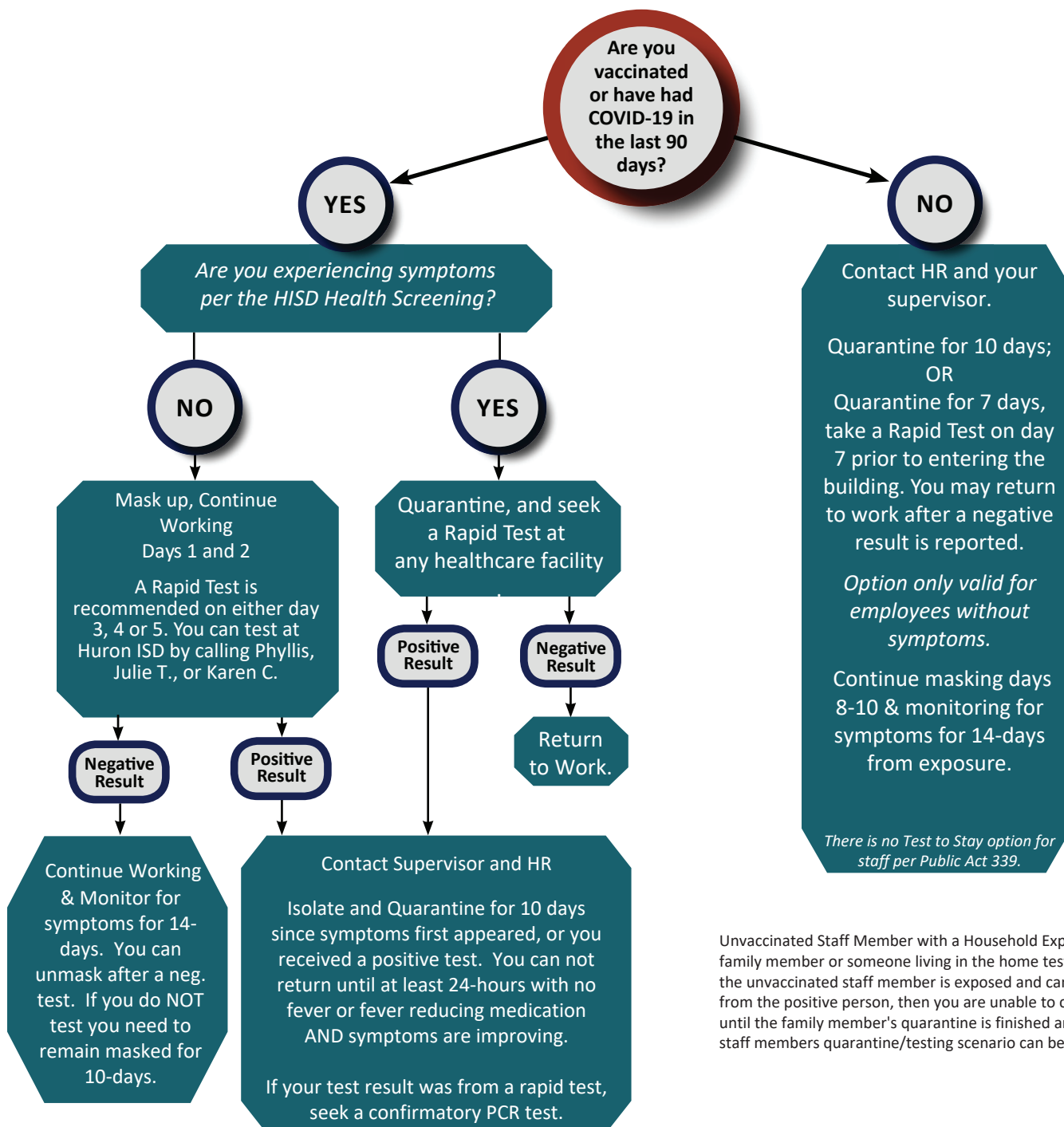

What happens when a staff member has "Close Contact" with a COVID-Positive Individual, or is symptomatic per the HISD Health Screening?

A close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period. Report all such close contact exposures to HR.



Per CDC/HISD Guidelines



Unvaccinated Staff Member with a Household Exposure: If a family member or someone living in the home tests positive, and the unvaccinated staff member is exposed and cannot isolate from the positive person, then you are unable to come to work until the family member's quarantine is finished and then the staff members quarantine/testing scenario can begin.
