Principal Report:

- **Renovations:** Mr. Sams mentioned the improvements our school received over the last several months (blinds, paint, gym, hardware, etc.). Mr. Sams also stated there are some areas that are still needing to be fixed (restrooms, doors, gym).
- **Red Ribbon Week:** Student and teacher participation was great. There will be a holiday dress-up week before Christmas break.
- **Progress Reports:** These went home with the students November 3.
- **PBIS Update:** Positive Behavior Interventions and Support. Mr. Sams discussed how the committee for our district came by. He explained that PBIS promotes and reinforces what is done correctly and is built on a plan that not every student comes into a school setting knowing how to act. Dr. Brock heads PBIS for FM. Dr. Brock shared how students receive Wolf Bucks from teachers who show positive behavior and will soon receive a “payday” which will occur every 2 weeks. The payday will be worth \$10 in Wolf bucks and will allow students to purchase ice cream, hats, and candy. Students who have referrals will be able to attend the PBIS party every quarter.
- **FBLA-sock collecton, FCCLA-snacks for healthcare workers:** Both clubs participated in community service and will do more projects in the future.

- **Band/FFA Fundraiser:** These programs will be selling fruit.
- **Band Concert:** Concert will be December 12th at FMMS
- **Chorus Concert:** Concert will be December 13th and has been moved to Houston County High School to help with their new staff.
- **IXL Program:** MyPath isn't being utilized as much and isn't as engaging based on other schools reports. Therefore, our school purchased the IXL Program to help monitor student progress in Math and Reading came free with the program. The IXL team will conduct a teacher development opportunity on a teacher work day.
- **Centigex:** This device will be installed and each staff member will get a card. Each staff member will have the ability to squeeze the card which will then set up a lockdown which will be communicated to the central office, police and fire department. This card will also assist in a code blue situation. It will identify the location of the staff member.
