Helpful Hints

- When *c* is followed by the vowels *e* (*ce*) or *i* (*ci*), the sound of *c* changes from /k/ to /s/ (*cent*; *cite*).
- When *g* is followed by the vowels *e* (*ge*) or *i* (*gi*), the sound of *g* changes from /g/ to /j/ (*gem*; *gin*).
- When a consonant plus *c* or *g* comes between the first vowel and the silent *e*, the two consonants will act as guardians, making the first vowel short (*dance*, *prince*, *plunge*).
- English words never end in the letter *j*. When the sound /j/ is heard at the end of a word, it will always be spelled *ge*. Words with a long vowel sound will end with just the *ge* spelling (*cage*). Words with a short vowel sound will end with a *dge* spelling (*judge*; *bridge*).

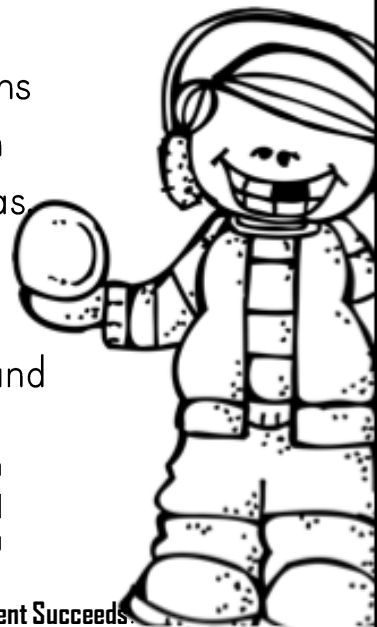
