Oregon Statewide Assessments, Grades 3-6

Students in grades three through six will be finishing the Oregon Statewide Assessments (OSAS) the first week of May. The OSAS scores are an important indicator of student progress in meeting grade-level benchmarks. District Campus Trail Project

Kindergarten Registration, 2022-2023

Kindergarten Registration Night has been scheduled for Wednesday, May 10 from 5:30-6:30 p.m. in the Hudson Park kindergarten classrooms and library. Please bring your incoming kindergarten student to the event. To enroll in kindergarten for the 2023-2024 school year, students must be 5 on or before September 1, 2023. Any kindergarten age-eligible student currently enrolled in Rainier Preschool or Head Start has been automatically enrolled for kindergarten for next school year. Some additional information may be needed for these students. Any kindergarten age-eligible student new to Rainier School District will need to register online in order to enroll in kindergarten. Online registration for next year opens May 1, 2023.

HPE Drug-Free Pep Rally for Fifth and Sixth Grade Students

We are excited to announce that we will be hosting a **Drug-Free Pep Rally for students in fifth and sixth grades** in partnership with the Columbia County Public Health Department and the Opioid Response Network on Wednesday, May 24. The purpose of the Drug-Free Pep Rally is to bring community, school and student leaders to help our students to make healthy choices about substance use. Hudson Park Elementary has an "opt-out" policy whereby the parent/guardian must sign a permission form to *withdraw* their student from participating in this event.
