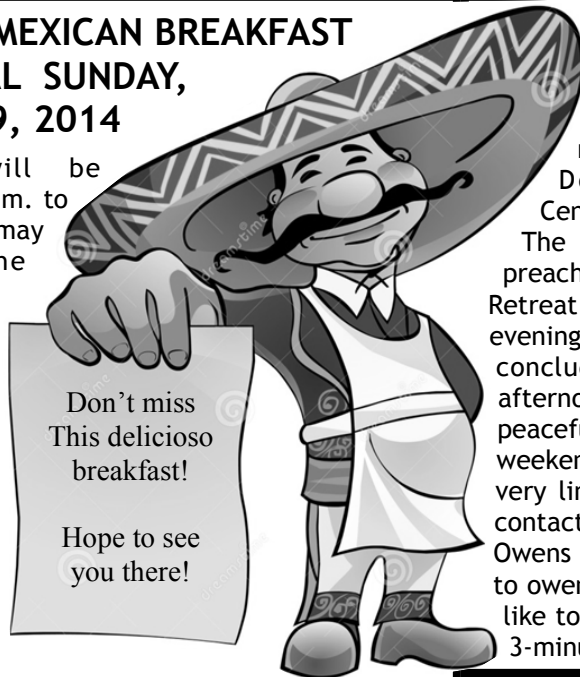

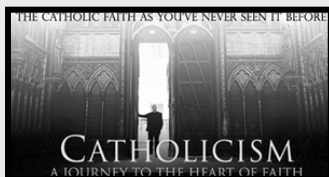

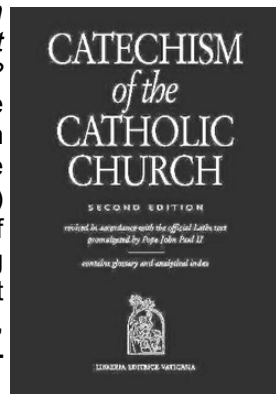

SECOND GRADE AT ST. THERESE SCHOOL

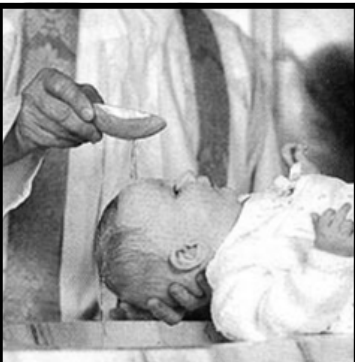

- In order to take part in our Baptism Program, **PARENTS & GODPARENTS** are required to attend a class from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the Parish Library (next dates are October 6 and November 4). The fee is \$100 per child or \$25 for the class only. Your child

will then be baptized on a Saturday (next open Baptisms are at Noon on October 25 and November 22).

SELECTING THE GODPARENTS: Canon Law requires you to have at least one godparent (may have two) who: 1) is at least 16; 2) has been Confirmed; and 3) is a practicing Catholic. A form attesting to this will need to be signed by a priest from the parish of each prospective godparent.
