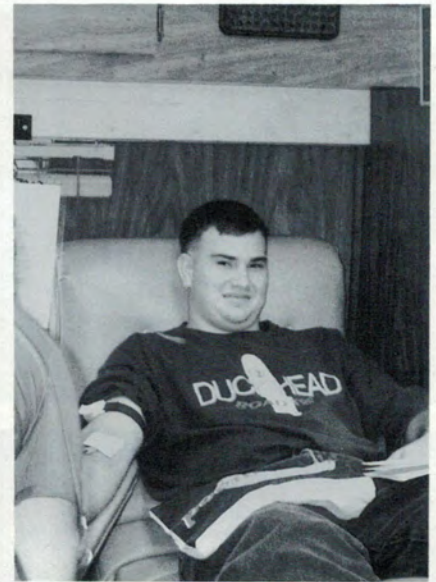




Stephanie flexes her biceps for Dwaine, but he seems to be more interested in something else, like her buns of steel perhaps.

At the Christmas Dance, Iyan is just worn out from all of that dancing, so she takes a little snooze, hoping that no one will notice. But we caught her!



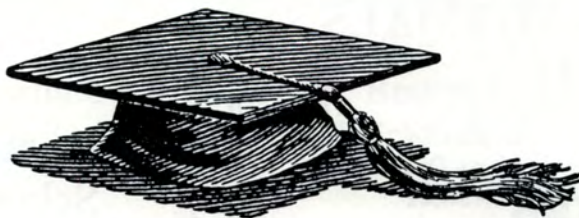

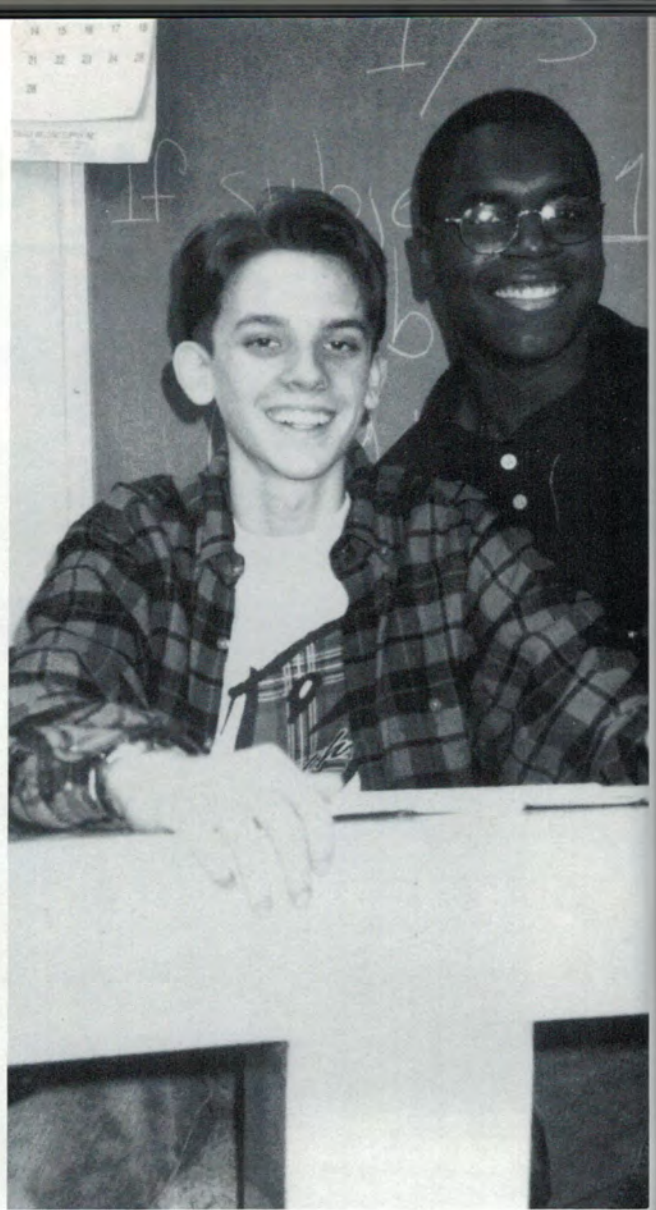

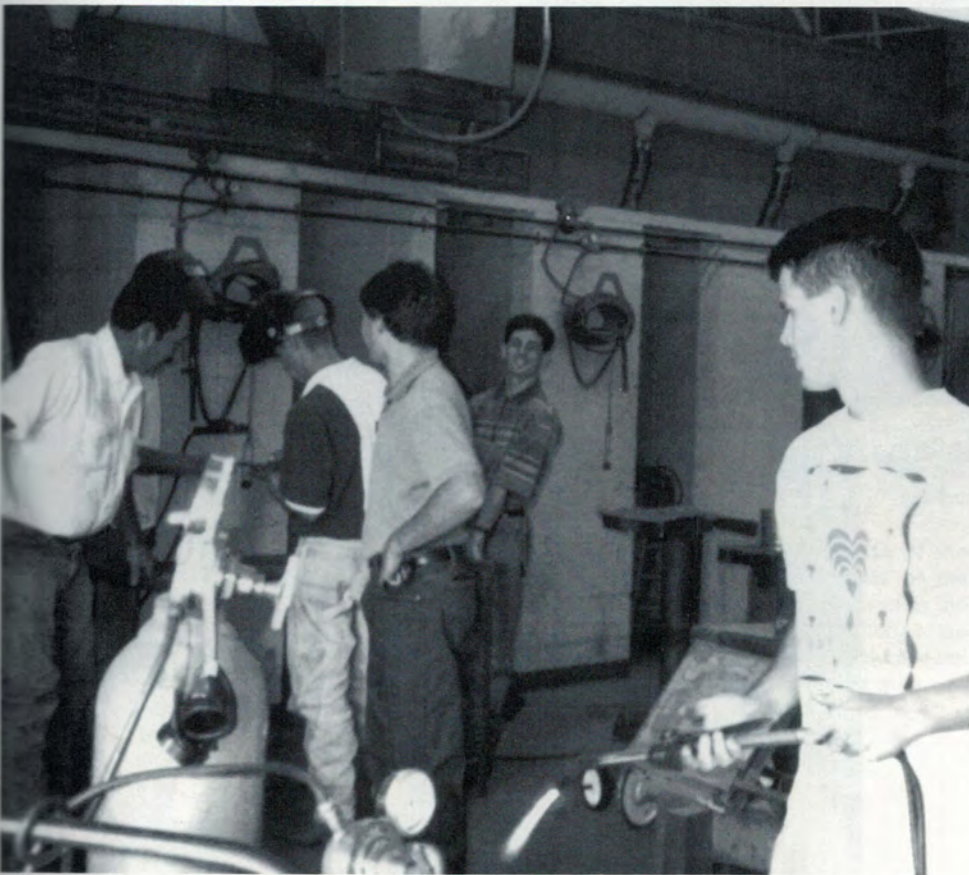
