Course Description

Workforce Readiness is a one credit course that is designed to provide students with academic and occupational skills that are transferable across jobs and occupational areas. Emphasis is placed on academic foundations for careers, applied technology, career development and employment, entrepreneurship and business economics, social and ethical responsibility, leadership, teamwork, safety and health.

Program: Workforce Readiness is an elective course for all of the career/technical programs in Autauga County.

Assessment

Each unit will contain various assignments, video questionnaires, worksheets, quizzes, tests, projects, etc., each having a point value. This will make up an accumulated unit grade. In addition, students will be able to earn work ethics points for attendance, participation and following classroom rules and procedures.

The nine - week grade will be determined by the following:

- 30% Projects
- 20% Tests
- 30% Daily
- 20% Management (Work Ethic) points (Attendance and punctuality, preparation, participation in activities, organizing tasks and following classroom rules and procedures.

 The semester grade will be determined by averaging the two nine—week grades.
