1st Grade

- ★ Students will be offered a redo assignment/assessment when they score a 1, on an assignment in an eligible subject area.

Eligible Subject Areas

Spelling Tests

Math Quizzes

- ★ The new assignment will be completed without assistance, and the student will be able to earn full credit back.

Formative Assessment Guidelines

2nd Grade

- ★ **Students will be offered a redo assignment/assessment when they score a D or lower on an assignment in an eligible subject area.**

Eligible Subject Areas

Spelling Tests
Math Quizzes

- ★ **Relearning work needs to be completed the day after it is given to be eligible for the redo opportunity.**
- ★ **The new formative assessment will be completed without assistance, and the average of the two tests will be recorded as the new grade.**
- ★ **All first-try scores will be reported to PowerSchool for parents to view. By clicking on the comment, parents will be able to view the first-try score.**

Assessment Guidelines

3rd Grade

★ General Redo Information

- any assessment, **earning a D or lower**, in all subjects
- redo communication is either written on the assignment or in the student's assignment notebook
- some assessments may not be eligible for a redo (i.e. extensive projects)

★ Formative Assessments~ (not a test or final project)

- corrected from the original work and completed with assistance from an adult or with the use of additional material (textbook, notes, etc.)
- student can earn back up to ½ credit based on performance (i.e.- an assignment that was a 50% on the first attempt could only end up at a 75%, if all questions were correct on the redo)
- redo must be completed within the time frame given by the teacher

★ Summative Assessments

- homework assigned before the summative assessment must be completed to qualify for a redo assessment
- redo assignment or relearning work will be given and must be turned in by the teacher-assigned date to be eligible for a new assessment
- students can earn full credit on the redo assessment. based on performance
- redo assessment must be completed in school without assistance

4th Grade

★ General Redo Information

- ❖ any formative assessment, **earning a D or lower**, in all subjects
- ❖ redo communication is either written on the assignment, in the student's assignment notebook, or will be noted in PowerSchool.
- ❖ some assessments may not be eligible for a re-do i.e., extensive projects

★ Formative Assessments

- corrected from the original work and completed with assistance from a teacher or with the use of additional material (textbook, notes, etc.)
- student can earn back up to ½ credit based on performance (i.e.- an assignment that was a 50% on the first attempt could only end up at a 75%, if all questions were correct on the redo.
- redo must be completed at school

★ Summative Assessments

- No redo opportunities will be given

★ **All first-try scores will be reported to PowerSchool for parents to view. By clicking on the comment, parents will be able to view the first-try score.**

Assessment Guidelines

5th Grade

★ General Redo Information

- ❖ Students will be offered a redo opportunity when they score a D or lower on any Skills-Based Formative Assessment in ELA or Math. (There are no redo opportunities in Science or Social Studies, or Application-Based Formative Assessments.)
- ❖ Redo communication is either written on the assignment or in the student's assignment notebook.
- ❖ Some assessments may not be eligible for a redo (i.e., extensive projects or writing pieces) as feedback will be given throughout the assignment.

★ Formative Assessments

- To be eligible for a redo opportunity on a Skills-Based Formative Assessment:
 - the score earned needs to be a D or lower
 - students complete the redo assignment or relearning work by the assigned date
 - all homework assigned before the Skills-Based Formative Assessment must be completed
- Students can earn full credit on these redo assessments based on performance.
- These assessments will be completed in school.

★ Summative Assessments

- No re-do opportunities will be given.

★ **All first-try scores will be reported to PowerSchool for parents to view. By clicking on the comment, parents will be able to view the first-try score.**
