2. Purpose of this meeting – to evaluate the effectiveness of current Title I.A programs and discuss plans for next year.
3. Title I.A

- a. Present and discuss student achievement data

I-Ready Diagnostic information for the district were presented by Mrs. Cassidy Herrin for Reading and Math. In Reading the district has 10 Students mid or above grade level, 8 students early on grade level, 16 students one grade level below, 4 students two grade levels below and 4 students three or more grade levels below. In Math the district has 4 students mid or above grade level, 5 students early on grade level, 13 students one grade level below, 4 students two grade levels below and 2 students three or more grade levels below.

Mrs. Sheri Vestal and Mrs. Elizabeth Crutcher presented information regarding Foundations achievements and DRA achievements. First grade Foundations testing average is 93%, Second grade is 89% and Third grade is 85%. Sixty percent of students made significant improvements on the DRA and have moved on to their next level.

- b. Review results from parent surveys

Results of the parent surveys for Title and Family Engagement were presented by Mrs. Patricia Hancock. We had 13 parent responses to our Title Parent Survey. The responses indicated that the communication between the staff and families was excellent, most had attended parent teacher conferences and Family Fun Nights and found them adequate and engaging.

- c. Discuss the program's strengths and weaknesses

Those in attendance completed a verbal needs assessment. We found that our strengths and weaknesses seemed to be about the same as the prior year. K-8 Phonics, general vocabulary supplemental programs and non-fiction reading are working well, as well as, Math Numbers, operations and upper level measurement and data.

Our Weaknesses are in K-8 Comprehension, subject related specific vocabulary (Math, Science, Social Studies), and K/1 measurements/data. Operations and fractions are also in need of improvement.

Some suggestions for next year include: Creating a read a loud program with big books for the lower grades to help with comprehension. It was also suggested to have a Reading Challenge program that students/families would track how many pages they have read and we would provide some type of awards recognition. To help improve math measurement we will be continuing the After-School Club and offer more opportunities with a cooking class, etc.

d. Review the school parent compact

The current school, parent, student compact was reviewed and there were no suggestions for changes. However, it was suggested to include the compact in the paper copy of the handbook that is reviewed with the students and sent home at the beginning of the school year.

e. Review the School, Parent and Family Engagement Policy

Most felt that we should go back to having a table at our Back to School Picnic to better inform families about the opportunities to volunteer, how to stay informed, and available committees to serve on.

f. Review the Schoolwide Program Plan

Both the Family Engagement and Schoolwide Plan copies were provided for each attendee. Discussion was held and the only changes that they felt we needed to have were the ones held during discussion about our strengths and weaknesses, and recommendations for both policies.

g. Open discussion and suggestions that could improve the program/instruction, recommendations and revisions of Title I.A services.









Did you receive student progress reports?





Have you been kept well informed of the activities of the school?










