

Week of: October 28th – November 1st

Theme: Pumpkins



This week will consist of the theme focused on pumpkins. We will be focusing on the letter:
I and number: 9 this week.

We will learn about the life cycle of a pumpkin, the resources needed to grow a pumpkin, and the difference between a living and nonliving pumpkin. We will have whole group and small groups. Music and movement will consist of singing and dancing to themed songs. We will attend music class on Thursday! We will continue our classroom jobs and journals. For science, we will dissect pumpkins! We will have a fun letter I themed activity! We will continue to review shapes. We will work on the following literacy skills: letter identification and letter sounds. Using pumpkins and Candy Corn, we will work on the following math skills: counting, number identification, quantifying, sorting, measuring, patterns, and graphing. We will strengthen our fine motor skills by writing our names, letters, and numbers. This week will be filled with fun while learning about our letters, numbers, and pumpkins!
