Dear Parishioners,

The last weekend of July already. It seems summer is too quickly passing. I hope that those that need some time of rest this summer yet find it!

Last weekend, two particular things occurred, and I failed to look ahead. First, Pope Francis has asked that the Sunday before the Feast of Ss. Anne and Joachim (July 26) be a day for remembering grandparents and the elderly. I know that there are other days throughout the year for such remembrances, but this Catholic one makes sense as we honor the parents of the Blessed Virgin and the grandparents of Jesus. They are not mentioned in the Scriptures, but rather are found in the oral tradition and some in the Protoevangelium of St. James (not canonical scripture because it is not clearly of apostolic origin despite its name). They were a holy couple who longed and prayed for a

They were a holy couple who longed and prayed for a child. Despite approaching advanced years, they were able to conceive, and they dedicated their daughter to the Lord, who committed her life to virginity and prayer. She was then called by the Lord to be the Mother of God. According to our faith, the Lord saved Mary from original sin from the first moment of her conception (the Doctrine of the Immaculate Conception), but that she was conceived in the 'natural' way otherwise.

Also, July 24, marks the anniversary of the promulgation of the Encyclical Evangelium Vitae – on the Gospel of Life – by Pope Saint Paul VI in 1968. Because of that, we also mark a week of special awareness of Natural Family Planning methods which are in full conformity of the teachings of the Church. There are several methods, each much more advanced scientifically than the so-called rhythm method which was ineffective. Indeed, these methods chart the signs of fertility, and should a couple have a just reason to delay the possibility of a pregnancy, they abstain from sexual activity during the mutual fertile time.
