Bonaire Middle School FFA Chapter Named 2021 National Middle School Model of Excellence

Bonaire Middle School hosted several initiatives over the year to meet the diverse needs of its members and community. During the global pandemic, the chapter invited the school counselor to speak with members,

helping them deal with the stress of the unusual times. They also offered an organizational boot camp to help members struggling with their organizational skills. The chapter worked heavily with four area animal shelters and rescues to raise awareness about pet adoption and hosted a supply drive in local businesses.

The National Chapter Award program recognizes outstanding FFA chapters that actively implement the organization's mission and strategies. These chapters improve chapter operations using the National Quality FFA Chapter Standards and a Program of Activities that emphasizes growing leaders, building communities, and strengthening agriculture. Chapters are rewarded for providing educational experiences for the entire membership.

National FFA recognizes the top chapters with innovative activities in each of the three divisions: growing leaders, building communities and strengthening agriculture. Chapters that receive three-star ratings during judging are eligible to compete for the premier chapter awards. Five FFA chapters

competed for the honor. Bonaire Middle School FFA was recognized as the winner during the second general session on Thursday, Oct. 28.
