8. Oracle Ridge Advisory Committee Report

Mrs. Edie Crall updated the Governing Board with progress related to the Oracle Ridge campus since our May 2022 Governing Board meeting.

 Discussion regarding Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) state proficiency averages and District proficiency averages during the Spring 2022 assessment window. A formal Student Achievement Report will be delivered to the Governing Board during the July 2022 Regular Meeting.

Mrs. Nehrmeyer and Mrs. Soule shared Mountain Vista K-8 School proficiency percentages by grade level for ELA (reading and writing) and Math as compared to state averages. We are making progress and *moving the needle!* Discussion held.

10. Discussion and request for approval of an agreement between RNA Facilities Management and the District for FY2022-2023.

The District entered into a similar agreement with City Wide Facilities Management through June 30, 2022. During the formal procurement process for FY 23, the District received a bid from RNA Facilities Management. Based on this bid from RNA Facilities Management, Mrs. Nehrmeyer recommended the Board approve the attached agreement for custodial services effective July 1, 2022 and through June 30, 2023, including the attached addendum recommended by the District's legal counsel. RNA Facilities Management is an approved vendor

through the state procurement co-cop (Mohave) and as referenced in the attached spreadsheet, will provide a cost savings to the District when compared to City Wide.

Mrs. Lyon moved and Mr. Gotay seconded the motion with provision that both the agreement and the addendum are signed by both vendor and District for contract to be valid, all in favor, motion carried.

Mrs. Nehrmeyer recommended the Governing Board approve the student and staff handbooks for the upcoming school year, with District created handbooks for both students and staff printed by Alphagrapics in Tucson.
