Since last Friday 54 employees and 107 students report testing positive with COVID. This spike in COVID is expected to continue for several weeks which may force individual schools to shift to a virtual platform as we have done in the past if necessary. Having said that we continue to encourage everyone to take any necessary precautions, especially those with health issues. The CDC has changed COVID quarantine guidelines and Elmore County has adapted procedures to address the change which can be found on the Elmore County Public Schools Website under COVID Update.
