

2024-2025 Kindergarten Readiness Packet





We are so excited your family will be a part of the *Shirley Hills School Community!* Here at *Shirley Hills (SHES)* we believe it takes us all (teachers, parents, and students) to help a child be successful in school. The items listed in blue coloring are Kindergarten goals that must be mastered by the end of the school year. Below are some suggested activities to help your child meet these goals.

1. IDENTIFY AND WRITE FIRST AND LAST NAME

Suggested Activities

a. Start with the first name. Make sure your child is holding their pencil or crayon properly. Make sure to say each letter as you write it. *Only focus* on writing the letters first. Students can work on making it look neat later in the process.

2. KNOWING THE ALPHABET (identify and write 52/52 letters/produce 26/26 sounds)

Suggested Activities

- a. Be able to identify all 26 letters of the alphabet in (Uppercase (Start with these first) and Lowercase).
 - i. **Hint:** Use your child's name to point out letters of the alphabet.
- b. Know all the Alphabet letter sounds.
 - i. **IMPORTANT** A child will need to be able to know letter sounds first before they can work on letter identity.
 - ii. Watch a video on letter sounds to get you started. Try any <u>Jack Hartman video on YouTube.</u>
- c. Be able to write the Alphabet Letters in Upper and Lowercase.
 - i. Have your child trace out letters you created on paper with space around each one.
 - ii. Finger-paint the letters.
- d. Sing the ABC song.
 - i. Make sure to sing slowly the "L, M, N, O" portion of the song. When we sing these letters quickly it can sound like a long letter.

3. SIGHT WORDS (Read and Write all 22 words)

Suggested Activities

a. Sight words help your child to get a head start in reading. Knowing sight words eliminates the need to sound out every single word.

4. MATH (Count, identify, and write to 20, and count backwards from 20)

Suggested Activities

- a. Count from 1-20
 - i. It is extremely helpful if your child knows 1-10 before starting Kindergarten.
 - ii. You can count anytime. Spend time pointing out how many there are of something. (Dogs, Tress)
- b. Identify numbers from 1-20
 - i. Point out numbers daily as you see them. Examples of this would be in recipes, on a sign, in a book and at the store.
- c. Write the numbers from 1 20
 - i. Write numbers using Finger Paint
 - ii. Write the numbers and have your child trace over them.
- d. Count backwards from 20
 - I. Practice counting down from 5, 10, 15, and then 20 until your child shows mastery (can use number cards or a chart)

5. READING (Blend and Segment CVC words, ex: cat, dog, top)

Suggested Activities

- a. Parents and Children can read to each other.
- b. Talk about the story afterwards.
 - i. What was the story about?
 - **ii.** Talk about the pictures in the story.
 - **iii.** Can you relate to something in the story?
- c. Practice sounding out words.

6. HOW TO REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR KINDERGARTEN

*** The registration process below is for new students who did not attend Pre-K in the Houston County Public School System. ***

- 1. Make an appointment by visiting www.hcbe.net/Centralregistration.or call 478.741.3610
- 2. Complete the Online Registration Form

Central Registration Address

(Near Houston County High School)

<u>Items to bring with you to your appointment.</u>

- Parent/Guardian Phone ID
- Certified Birth Certificate or Passport
- Social Security Card or Wavier
- Georgia Form 3231- Immunization Certificate
- Georgia Form 3300- Eye, Ear, Dental, Nutrition Screening
- Guardianship/Custody Orders (if applicable)
- Withdrawal Form/Latest Report Card
- Two proofs of Residency

- The <u>FIRST</u> must be a **LEASE or MORTGAGE** Statement (if home is paid off.
- The **SECOND** must be one of the following:
 - 1. Current Utility Bill that shows your current address
 - 2. Property Tax Statement that shows current address
 - 3. Automobile Registration or Insurance Policy that shows it being sent to current address.
 - 4. Mail from any government agency sent to current address

NOTES

- If your lease is expired and, on a month-to-month agreement, the second proof
 of Residency <u>MUST BE</u> a current utility bill.
- All families new to the county but not the state of Georgia, need to provide a disconnect notice for previous address.
