The workshop will help participants better understand how economic circumstances affect behaviors and mindsets and the importance of developing stronger relationships with individuals from poverty. Participants will understand how to more effectively meet the needs of under-resourced families and children in a variety of settings and how to use the hidden rules of economic groups to be more effective in the classroom and community.
