Attendance

If you know ahead of time that your child will be tardy, checking out, or absent, PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE let us know!! This will help us with making sure your child doesn't fall behind.

Arrival

*CARPOOL and WALKERS:

- Carpool will be in the front of the school. Students will enter the building through the front, red hall doorway.
- Carpool drop off begins at 7:10 and ends at 7:55. If you arrive after 7:55, you must park your car and walk your child into school to sign them in.
- The front parking lot is closed until 7:55 each morning. Students are NOT allowed to be dropped off in the front parking lot.
- If carpool students need to eat breakfast, they must go to the lunchroom and eat BEFORE coming to the purple hallway.





Arrival

*BUS RIDERS:

- Bus riders will be dropped off on the side of the school by the gym.
- Students will enter the school through the side, yellow hall doors (by the gym) and be sent into the gym.
- The students will follow a breakfast rotation schedule from the gym to limit the amount of kids eating breakfast at one time. Students will return back to the gym after finishing breakfast.
- At the 7:45 bell, students will be released to the purple hallway.





Dismissal

- Walkers will be dismissed out the front exterior doors at 2:50. If you walk to the school to meet your child, please wait for your child at the walker pick-up sign. Parents are not allowed under the breezeway. You may NOT park in the front parking lot to pick up your child if they're a walker. (park on Tara Drive)
- Carpool will start at 3:00 in the front of the school.
- Parents must go to the carpool table in the lunchroom to receive an account and a hang tag for afternoon carpool. (No hang tag is needed for morning drop off.)
- Each hang tag is specific to your child. You must have the hang tag in order to pick up your child in the carpool line.

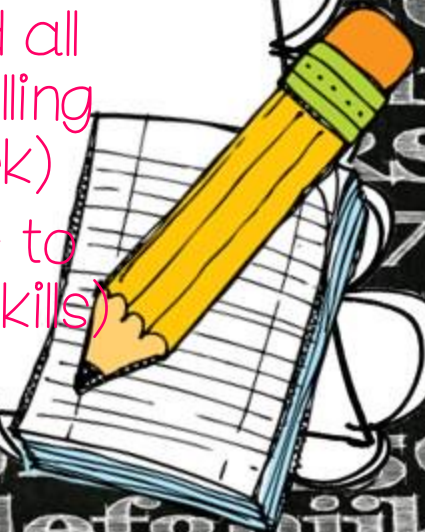


Reading/Language Arts

Each week on my website you will find all the information you will need for any assignments/tests.

There are 3 VERY important sections:

Math/Science/Social Studies

Check my website each week.

At the top of my page, you will find 3 sections titled: math, science, and social studies.

Under each subject, I will have the assignments/tests that will take place each day that week. I will also list any future dates that are important under those sections.

**Math – topic tests and quizzes

**SS – newspaper quizzes/tests, states and capitals

**Science – quizzes, tests, projects



Graded Papers

Students will receive folders with their graded papers every other week, typically Thursday. All papers for that class will be stapled together with a note on the front listing reminders and all papers that are included in the packet. Please review the grades, sign the note at the top, and return the packet to school in the folder the following day.

We STRONGLY suggest you regularly check PowerSchool so that you are aware of your child's academic progress (and there aren't any surprises when progress reports or report cards are sent home!)
