

 the Navajo Census—my father is Laguna and my mother is Navajo. I have lived here
 since I was five years old. With my dad's line of work we lived in Isleta (age 2-3)
 and Mescalero (age 4). I attended Head Start in both places. I attended Laguna
 Elementary from kindergarten through sixth grade and then transitioned into
 public school in Grants in the seventh grade.
- I have been a teacher for over 20 years and have been exclusive to the Laguna Division of Early Childhood, with a brief break to help care for my father in 2020. I began my LD0E journey in February of 2002 as a substitute and was asked if I wanted to become a teacher assistant in the infant room at Laguna Early Head Start. My answer was, "Yes!" At that time, there were nine infants/toddlers and three teachers in each classroom. I learned about the Head Start Performance Standards, Developmentally Appropriate Practice (DAP) and meal patterns. I gathered on-the-job experience and training, which was intimidating due to the lack of time. Although I have lived here "forever", I don't know many people. It was hard for me to ask for help, which I think is very true for most people.
- What I have learned while working at DEC, is that we like helping people and we give support to one another.
- I have earned an Associate's degree in both Computer Science and Early



- I have worked with LDOE for 16 years since receiving my Master's Degree in Social Work in 2004. I also worked for Laguna Social Services a total of four years, beginning in 2004. I currently work with all LDOE schools from Early Head Start to Laguna Middle School. My title at DEC is Mental Health Consultant. This means that I do not work directly (provide therapy or counseling) with any children at DEC. My job is to provide consultation or support to the adults in children's lives so they can, in turn, better support the children. An example of this is if there is a child exhibiting aggressive behaviors in the classroom or is usually outgoing then suddenly withdraws, the teacher or parent/guardian will notify me and I will work with the teacher and parent/guardian to support the child both at school and at home. This support may be through training or by providing information, activities, or ideas to the parent and teacher. I am also a part of the Children's Support Team. This team convenes when a child requires extra support from outside DEC or if a Behavior Support Plan needs to be developed. This team is made up of pertinent DEC staff and parents/guardians.

It is a 10 session training on the curriculum that is being used in your child's classroom. Consistency is one of the most important factors in preventing unwanted behaviors children exhibit. 




