

### HYSHAM SCHOOL DISTRICT 1 NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE NONVOTED LEVIES MARCH 2024

The Board of Trustees of Hysham School District 1 hereby resolves to consider and adopt the following changes in revenues/mills from Adult Education, Building Reserve Permissive, General Fund, Technology, Transportation, and Tuition funds of the K-12 School District for school fiscal year 2025.

Be it further resolved, that as an essential part of its budgeting process, the Hysham School District Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Hysham School District Board of Trustees estimates the following increases/decreases in revenue and mills for the funds noted below for the next school year beginning July 1, 2024 using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:

The Permissive Levy associated with building improvements is managed through the Building Reserve Fund. The annual amount for the Building Reserve Fund levy is established by formula via OPI.

Impacts above are based on current year 2023-2024 certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year.

Be it resolved that the Hysham School District Board of Trustees approves the resolution of intent to increase/decrease fund levies as presented above for school fiscal year 2024-2025.

The Hysham FFA had eighteen members attend the program's state convention in Billings at the Metra April 2-6. These members competed in a series of contests, attended sessions, danced Friday night away, and earned degrees.

The contests that Hysham students competed included the following: mechanics, horse, livestock, meats, poultry, vet, and sales. The mechanics teams placed 50th, horse placed 40th (Reagan Fink placed 17th individually), and livestock placed 27th (Liz Moke placed 30th individually). Meats placed 11th (Jo Hopf placed 22nd individually), poultry placed 15th, vet placed 57th, and sales placed 44th.

Three individual were honored for earning their state degrees, the highest degree given in the state: Jo Hopf, Sam Roberts, and Tamra Taber all were recognized at a dinner honoring this achievement.
