

Following the Mass, teachers had a choice of breakout sessions that focused on STREAM, technology, student assessments, instructional strategies, apps, and more. This year, our teachers in grades PreK 3 – 8th are incorporating Legos, robotics, and the Gifts of C.H.R.I.S.T. into their lessons to engage, to promote creativity, and to encourage problem-solving.

Socratic Circles-Fostering Critical Thinking

Our 8th graders received an introduction to the Socratic Seminar approach to learning. The circles consist of an inner and outer circle of students. After reading and researching documents on the Declaration of Independence, the inner circle must question, discuss, and debate the elements of life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness using textual evidence. The outer circle of students is responsible for critiquing their performance.
