The Vacancy

River Valley Local School District is seeking a qualified financial leader for the position of **Treasurer**. North Central Ohio Educational Service Center (NCOESC) is assisting the Board with its search. All applications will be reviewed by the River Valley Local School Board of Education.

About the District and Community

The River Valley Local School District (RVLSD) is located in Caledonia, Ohio, and includes the areas of Claridon, Martel, and Waldo. The district serves nearly 1,900 students across 121 square miles of eastern Marion County and portions of Morrow County. Situated to the east of U.S. Route 23, River Valley has a strong agricultural tradition with multiple commercial industries and several state routes running through the district. River Valley’s proximity to Delaware and Franklin counties makes it a viable commuter option for residents. Generations of River Valley families call the district home, and a deep sense of Viking pride exists among the community. The River Valley district has four schools: two elementaries, one middle, and one high school.

Over the past five years, River Valley has distinguished itself as the pre-eminent district in Marion County. From academic success and career pathway expansion, to athletic and extra-curricular accomplishments, River Valley continues to show a high level of excellence in all of these areas. Academically, River Valley has consistently been the top-scoring district in Marion County the last five years on the Ohio State Tests. The district offers multiple career pathways for students, including Healthcare, Construction Trades, and two Agriculture-related pathways, to go with our strong FFA program. River Valley also offers competitive athletic programs as well as Band, Choir, and Orchestra (for grades 4-12), allowing our students to be well-rounded in numerous extra-curricular activities.

The River Valley community showed tremendous support for the schools in 2023 by voting to pass a combination Bond and Permanent Improvement (PI) Levy and renewing the earned Income Tax. The Bond allowed the district to address \$10 million in much-needed maintenance projects for our 20+ year-old buildings, including: district-wide roof replacement, asphalt paving and repairs, as well as HVAC upgrades, and tennis courts replacement. The PI fund will address ongoing yearly maintenance and repairs as well as purchases such as school buses, technology, and facility upgrades, while the Income Tax is used for daily operations.
