The Pottsville School District Board of Education met in a regular session on April 21, 2022 in the High School Library. Board President Clint Hull called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. All board members were present.

April Students of the Month were recognized.

Voted 5-0 to approve the consent agenda that included the following: M. – Potts, S. – Taylor.

Voted 5-0 to accept the request for additional concrete around the bleachers to support the awning that will be attached. This is an additional 1,000 dollars, bringing the total to 124,531 dollars. M. – Huffman, S. – Taylor.

Voted 5-0 to approve the school improvement plans and the district literacy plan. M. – Akin, S. – Taylor.

Voted 5-0 for the proposed policy that was requested by the PPC to allow employees to use one more sick day as a personal day beginning 2022-2023 school year. M. – Huffman, S. – Akin.

Voted 5-0 to accept the resignations of Greg Sutterfield, Denise Garrigus, Brenda McAnulty, David Reed, Jackie Taylor, Chuck Standridge, Josh Ward, Kane Bradley and Taylor Robinson. M. – Taylor, S. – Potts.

Voted 5-0 to reemploy Jenece Clark for the 2022-2023 school year and to hire Sharon Biggs for High School Secretary/Student Management Coordinator, Jessica Sullivan and Rashelle Underhill for the High School Math positions, Katherine Mobbs for the Junior High Math position, Brandi Lauckner and Ashley Harris for Elementary Teachers, Dirk Thompson as an hourly employee for 16 hours for the month of May and 20 hours a week for the remainder of the summer to help with lawncare, and to rehire all current Classified Employees. M. – Akin, S. – Huffman.

Voted 5-0 for the salary adjustments for the 2022-2023 school year:

1. Add a year to the base for all salary columns to ensure all employees receive a step of experience on the scale. Certified and Classified.
2. Add to the base of our school resource officers. This will allow them to be off the buses and keep them on campus for more hours.
3. Create a new classified salary column for high school secretary/student management coordinator.
4. Adjust all administrators indexes as discussed. M. – Potts, S. – Akin.
