With approximately 75 million dollars available for Idaho LAUNCH funding, it is possible for this program to offer between 9,000 and 10,000 awards per year • Graduate from an Idaho High School or equivalent, starting in Spring 2024 • Be an Idaho resident • Be enrolled in or have applied to an in-demand career program at an eligible Idaho institution • Begin enrollment by Fall Semester after graduation • Complete a Career Pathway Plan • Review the approved list of eligible in-demand careers	80% of tuition and fees up to \$8,000 (receive up to ½ of funds in year 1 (\$4000), unless enrolled in a program that is less than 12 months.

Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE)

- The **WUE** is a tuition savings program that makes attending out-of-state colleges and universities more affordable for students. Through WUE, you can receive a reduced tuition rate to over 160+ institutions. For more information:
