McKinney-Vento Homeless Education Act

McKinney - Vento Act Ensures Educational Rights and Protection for Youth and Children Experiencing Homelessness



Children and youth who lack fixed, regular and adequate nighttime residence, including children and youth who are:

- Living in motels, hotels, cars, public spaces, abandoned buildings, or similar settings due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations
- Living in emergency or transitional housing
- Unaccompanied youth, including any youth not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian, such as runaways, or youth denied housing by their families
