Dear Parishioners,

Congratulations to David Rabaey as he was formally installed as a Lector last week at St. Paul Seminary. This is the first formal step of Holy Orders. He is now commissioned to read the readings.

Next Sunday, we will celebrate the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation for a number of our parishioners. Bishop Zielinski will of course offer this Sacrament in which

they will be fully initiated into the Church.

Reflect on that a bit, and I think we might see something of a challenge. It is a Sacrament of Initiation – not completion. It begins the full relationship in the Church, and it is my prayer that the newly confirmed will continue to grow in their love of Jesus Christ, living with the Holy Spirit.

A week from this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. More on that next week, but with some formal discussions about coming to a common date for Easter, it might be interesting to look at

what the difference is.

Easter often coincides with the Jewish celebration of Passover, as our Lord was celebrating a Passover meal on Holy Thursday. Jewish people celebrated Passover on the full moon during the month of Nissan. Because of it being a lunar calendar, our celebration of Easter does not always coincide with the Month of Nissan – we added that it would be the first full moon of spring, which begins on the vernal equinox.

Therefore, Good Friday is celebrated on the first Friday after the full moon after the Spring equinox. This means that Easter can be celebrated as early as March 20 (when the full moon would be on the equinox, which is very rare) to April 25 (the

next time it falls on this date is 2038).

Some of the Eastern Churches maintain the connection to Nissan, which means the date of their celebration of the Lord's resurrection doesn't always coincide with our celebration. This year, Easter is April 20, so fairly late in the chart of possible dates. This year, both the East and the West will celebrate Easter on the same day.

Pope Francis, however, is inviting all to come to one date from here on. This should not disturb us, as the reality is that the Lord was crucified on a Friday around the celebration of Passover (Ss. Matthew, Mark, and Luke record that He was crucified the day after Passover, while St. John records he was

crucified on the preparation day of Passover).

We do celebrate the fact of His resurrection even though we know that to attempt to replicate the date exactly is not possible. At this point, I don't expect a decision soon, but it is something the be aware of. (It's kind of like the discussion of eliminating Daylight Saving Time!)






