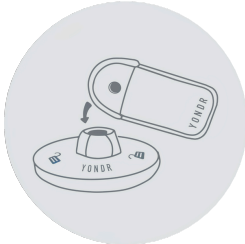

Arrival Procedure

Before entering the building students should place their phone, earbuds, and smart watch in the pouch. Students close and secure their pouch keeping it with them throughout the day.

Dismissal Procedure

At the end of 7th period, students will tap their pouch to the Base to retrieve their device(s).

If a student has an early dismissal, students will tap their pouch to the base in an administrative office before leaving.

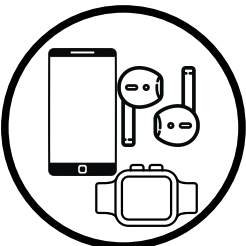

Phone Out Of Pouch

In accordance to the Student Code of Conduct, the offense is designated as a B-06: Use of electronic devices including communication and emerging technologies- While on campus, devices shall be powered off and stored away until the dismissal bell rings. Progressive discipline as stated in the Student Code of Conduct will be followed.

Forgotten Pouch

Any student discovered to be in possession of a cellular phone or other electronic device during time the device(s) should be secured inside a Yondr pouch and that student states that he/she "forgot" to bring their assigned Yondr pouch to campus must immediately surrender his/her cellular phone or other electronic device to the administrative office. A parent or guardian must then retrieve the device.

Lost/Damaged Pouch

Any student/parent reports a Yondr pouch lost, stolen, or damaged to the point that prevents the pouch from successfully closing will be required to purchase a new pouch for \$30.00. If a pouch cannot be purchased, the student CANNOT bring his/her electronic devices, including "smart" watches, earbuds, and cell phones, on campus for any reason. If student is found with a device on campus, the procedures from "Phone Out Of Pouch" - from #3 above - will be followed.
