Dear Parents of NCSI warriors:

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. I hope some of you are attending the Parenting training at Flagstaff Thursday and Friday of this week. It is that time of the year again, the last quarter of the School year. We will be testing most of this Spring: BIE Math and ELA; Cognia Science and NWEA End of the Year.

TESTING: Please make sure your children are not absent from school on testing days. **Grades 3, 4, and 5th will be testing tomorrow-April 3, Thursday-4/4 and Friday-4/5**. If they make perfect attendance during testing days, they will earn a trip to town for a Movie and Pizza. Please encourage your students to go to bed early to get enough sleep. Make sure they have a good breakfast and get to school on time. Please encourage them to try their best and use test taking strategies, their teachers share with them in class. Please tell them to make good use of their time. They can skip around on the test within a subtest category and go back to the question they have not answered.

ABSENTEEISM: Please encourage your child to attend school daily. Please communicate with the School or Transportation if the bus comes too early or does not wait long enough on your child. If your child misses 10 consecutive days of school, they will automatically be dropped from School.
