

## Barry Hahn Primary School Uniform Policy



- 1. Uniform colors consist of white, khaki, navy, burgundy and hunter green.
- Uniformity will consist of pants, skirts, shorts, skorts, dresses/jumpers, collared shirts or uniform shirts in uniform colors. A plain white t-shirt, designated school t-shirts and/or sweatshirts may also be worn. No clothing with words or logos are allowed except school related clubs and the Barry Hahn Primary or Brandenburg Primary logo. All students must wear appropriately sized clothing.
- 3. Tennis Shoes/athletic shoes with rubber soles that either tie or Velcro are required. Please no slip on shoes.
- 4. Sweaters, sweatshirts, and vests are optional but need to be in uniform colors if worn. A tie that coordinates with the school uniform may be worn.
- 5. Any visible sock, tights, or leggings must be a solid color and free of logos, patterns, and/or labels. Allowable colors are black and uniform colors.
- 6. The last **Friday of the month** and other designated days will be identified as free dress day.
- 7. No hats or scarves of any kind will be worn during the school day unless designated as a school wide reward incentive.
- 8. Hair must be of natural color. Any permanent or temporary hair coloring is prohibited.

This policy became effective on the first day of the 2017-2018 school year.

Students not in compliance with uniformity guidelines will receive a letter home, call to parents, and/or be provided with a school uniform for the day.
